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Senzime awarded exclusive 5-year national supply contract with U.S. Veterans Affairs through its partner TrillaMed

Uppsala, Sweden, Aug 5, 2026 - Senzime AB (publ), a leader in precision-based perioperative monitoring solutions, today announced that the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Strategic Acquisition Center has awarded a five-year national Non-Expendable Equipment (NX EQ) contract for quantitative neuromuscular monitoring to TrillaMed, LLC, the authorized U.S. federal distributor of the Senzime TetraGraph[®] system. The contract follows a competitive national procurement process and establishes TetraGraph as the only quantitative neuromuscular monitoring solution currently available through the VA Strategic Acquisition Center's national contracting program.

The contract provides more than 170 VA hospitals and healthcare facilities across the nation's largest integrated healthcare system with streamlined access to Senzime's TetraGraph quantitative neuromuscular monitoring technology through pre-negotiated pricing and a simplified procurement process. Through the VA Strategic Acquisition Center's national contracting program, eligible facilities can rapidly implement evidence-based quantitative neuromuscular monitoring without the need for separate local competitive procurements.

"This national contract award represents another significant milestone for Senzime and reflects the increasing recognition of quantitative neuromuscular monitoring as an essential component of modern anesthesia practice," said Philip Siberg, Chief Executive Officer of Senzime. "Through our partnership with TrillaMed, VA hospitals nationwide will have streamlined access to TetraGraph technology, enabling clinicians to provide Veterans with the highest standard of perioperative care. We believe this agreement will substantially expand the adoption of our technology throughout the VA healthcare system over the next five years."

The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs serves more than nine million enrolled Veterans in the United States. This national agreement is expected to accelerate the adoption of quantitative neuromuscular monitoring throughout the Veterans Health Administration, further supporting the VA's commitment to delivering the highest standards of perioperative patient care.

The TetraGraph system utilizes electromyography (EMG) technology to deliver objective, quantitative measurements of neuromuscular function before, during, and after the administration of neuromuscular blocking agents and reversals. By providing real-time data, the system helps clinicians optimize timing of intubation, dosing and reversal decisions, supporting evidence-based practice and reducing the risk of residual neuromuscular blockade. TetraGraph is designed to support compliance with recent clinical guidelines published by anesthesiology societies, including the American Society of Anesthesiologists (ASA) and European Society of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care (ESAIC).
