

## IT – Relocation of Nasdaq Nordic and Nasdaq Baltic Secondary Data Center – Genium INET – REMINDER: Additional testing dates and Launch Weekend Schedule

As previously [communicated](#), Nasdaq Nordic (Nasdaq Copenhagen A/S, Nasdaq Helsinki Ltd, Nasdaq Iceland hf., Nasdaq Oslo ASA and Nasdaq Stockholm AB), Nasdaq Baltic (Nasdaq Tallinn AS, Nasdaq Riga AS and AB Nasdaq Vilnius), Nasdaq Clearing AB and Nasdaq CSD SE will relocate the secondary data center from PORT to STOCKHOLM SOUTH (Equinix SK2) during April-May, 2025. The relocation will impact all trading, clearing, market data and Nasdaq CSD production systems. The planned changes are subject, where relevant, to regulatory consent.

**This IT Notice includes connectivity testing and launch time schedules for Genium INET (Equity Derivatives clearing, Fixed Income and Commodities trading & clearing).**

**Customers with dual-site setup that have not adapted to the new failover IPs and ports in the STOCKHOLM SOUTH data center by April 26 will not have redundancy for their Genium INET Production sessions in case of technical disturbances in the primary data center VASBY.**

# Launch time schedule – Genium INET

## **Saturday April 26 → Final login verification to new failover IPs in Genium INET**

- New failover IPs and ports in STOCKHOLM SOUTH launched in Genium INET Production, and old failover IPs and ports in PORT decommissioned
- Primary IPs and ports in VASBY to remain unchanged
- **Final login verification to new failover IPs & ports will be available between 13:00 – 15:00 CEST.** This applies to:
  - Trading Workstation – Login verification
  - Clearing Workstation 1 (CW1) – Telnet
  - FIX Application migration – Login verification
  - OMnet Application migration – Login verification
  - TradeGuard – Login verification
  - ITCH/AMD – Heartbeats
  - GLIMPSE – Login verification
- System state during login test:
  - Markets will be in closed state
  - No order or trade report entry
  - ITCH Multicast and AMD will disseminate heartbeats only
- **Please confirm via e-mail to [technicalrelations@nasdaq.com](mailto:technicalrelations@nasdaq.com), as soon as you have completed your Genium INET migration of failover IPs and ports from PORT to STOCKHOLM SOUTH data center (latest by April 26 at 15:00 CEST)**
- **NOTE CHANGED TIME from 16:00 CEST to 17:00 CEST!**  
**Final Go/NoGo decision to be communicated via IT-Notice around 17:00 CEST: “Migration completed”, or “Rollback initiated”.**
  - **In case of “Migration completed”:** → **Secondary Data Center Relocation for Genium INET completed**
    - Genium INET in VASBY will remain as Primary Production site (No change to primary IPs)
    - Genium INET in STOCKHOLM SOUTH launched as the Secondary/Failover Production site (New failover IPs live in Production)
    - Genium INET in PORT discontinued (Old failover IPs decommissioned, no logins or ITCH MC feeds)
  - **In case of “Rollback initiated”:** **Sunday April 27 → Secondary Data Center Relocation for Genium INET postponed**
    - Genium INET in VASBY will remain as Primary Production site (No change to primary IPs)
    - Genium INET in PORT to remain as the Secondary/Failover Production site until further notice (old failover IPs still in use)
    - New Go-Live date to be communicated
